AGREEMENT TO SUPPLY AGED ANIMALS

The Animal Resources Centre can provide aged animals to meet the client’s specific needs. We however require that the following conditions need to be met in order to proceed with the request:

- An Ethics number is provided at the time the order is placed.
- Extra animals will be reserved and charged accordingly to ensure that the total number of animals required at shipment is supplied. As a basis this will be calculated as per below:
-25% extra if animals are requested below 12 months and 50% above 12 months (this may vary depending on strain, age and sex required).
- You will pay an initial invoice for the animals at 12 weeks of age, then monthly thereafter for weekly cage holding costs.
- You will agree to take the animals early if we need to close the barrier they are in and we are unable to move them.
- You will agree to take the animals early if it looks like the original number of animals ordered won’t make it to the required age.
- You will accept that the condition of the animals may look poor due to their age.
- + any additional conditions depending on order. E.g. there may be an extra charge for caging animals in small groups which require extra caging.
